## Newspapers Plus



Magazines & catalogs  
*Accepted at all recycling sites.*

- You can use brown paper bags to bundle the papers
- Flyers & inserts can also be included
- NO wet or yellowed paper



## CLEAR glass bottles & jars

*Accepted at all recycling sites.*

- Please rinse & sort by color
- Not necessary to remove labels
- NO light bulbs, window glass, or glass dishes

## Colored Glass - Blue/Green/Brown

### Only accepted at:

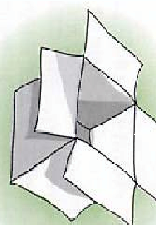
- *Beaver Island*
- *East Jordan*

## #1 and #2 Plastic bottles, jugs & jars



*Accepted at all recycling sites.*

- Look on the bottom for the number enclosed in a triangle formed by arrows
- Put the lids in the garbage
- Rinse and flatten
- NO #1 trays or clamshells
- NO brown #1 bottles
- NO #2 bags or tubs (yogurt, margarine)



## Cardboard Plus

Boxboard &  
brown paper bags

*Accepted at all recycling sites.*

- Remove packing materials
- Flatten boxes!
- Boxboard ie: cereal boxes, paper towel tubes
- NO boxes meant for use in coolers or freezers (pop can cases, butter boxes)
- NO styrofoam

## Cans Plus

Metal lids, foil trays and aluminum foil.

*Accepted at all recycling sites.*

- Rinse, remove labels
- Flatten (the best you can)
- Foil doesn't have to be perfectly clean, but shouldn't have pieces of food remaining on it.



## Office Paper Plus

Junk mail, file folders, envelopes

### ONLY accepted at:

*East Jordan &*

*Melrose Township*

- Remove CDs, credit cards
- NO padded envelopes, kraft envelopes, or boldly colored paper
